State policy on notification has changed with the enactment of RC 3321.042 (Am.Sub.HB 32). The effective date on this section has a 90-day waiting period under a requirement in the Ohio Constitution, Article II, sec. 1(c).

Therefore, ONLY for the 2023-2024 school year, the notification letter below needs to be sent to the local superintendent along with your typical notification (NOI) that is submitted in August. This will serve to establish an exemption from Ohio's compulsory attendance law, RC 3321.04.

Each academic year, thereafter, the deadline for filing the notification letter will be $\underline{\text{August 30.}}$
